### 1. The boy runs fast.

- The = Article
- boy = Noun
- runs = Verb
- fast = Adverb

### 2. She is my friend.

- She = Pronoun
- is = Verb
- my = Determiner (possessive)
- friend = Noun

### 3. They are playing football.

- They = Pronoun
- are = Verb (auxiliary)
- playing = Verb (present participle)
- football = Noun

### 4. He reads a book daily.

- He = Pronoun
- reads = Verb
- a = Article
- book = Noun
- daily = Adverb

### 5. The sun rises in the east.

- The = Article
- sun = Noun
- rises = Verb
- in = Preposition
- the = Article
- east = Noun

### 6. My teacher is kind.

- My = Determiner
- teacher = Noun
- is = Verb
- kind = Adjective

**7. We went to the park yesterday.**

- We = Pronoun
- went = Verb

- pen = Noun

- He = Pronoun
- runs = Verb
- quickly = Adverb
- but = Conjunction
- carefully = Adverb

- We = Pronoun
- saw = Verb
