4. Faculty Remarks:

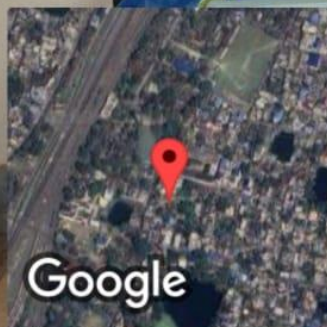
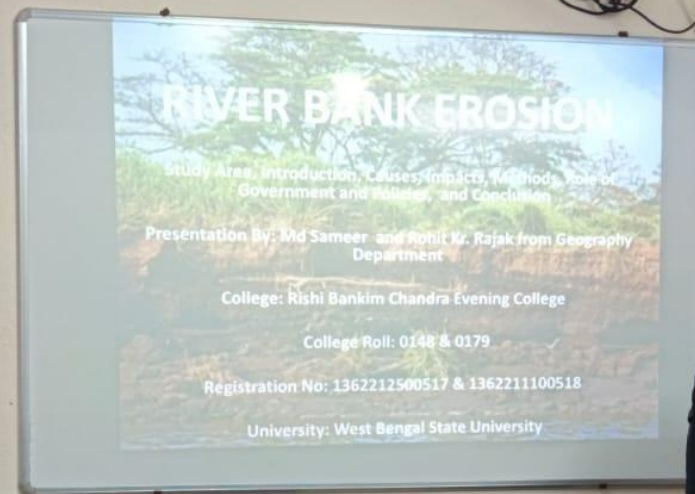
