Admission Criteria:

1. Not after more than 3 years of passing previous qualifying examination.
2. Passed in 100 marks English paper at 10+2 level
3. Aggregate calculated from top 4 subjects (but excluding the compulsory Environmental Science paper)
4. **For Honours – Must pass in Mathematics at 10+2 level**
AND
{(50% in aggregate + 45% in Economics) OR (55% in Economics) OR (50% in aggregate if Economics was not a subject at 10+2 level); 40% in aggregate and subject for SC/ST applicant.

Subject Groups offered:

- i) **Arts & Humanities:** English, Bengali, Hindi, Sanskrit, Philosophy, History, Political Science, Education, Journalism and Mass Communication, Film Studies
- ii) **Science:** Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Geography, Economics

Condition-

Not more than one subject can be taken up from any of the following 8 groups:

Group I	Physics, Education, Film Studies
Group II	History, Mathematics
Group III	Chemistry, Sanskrit
Group IV	Economics
Group V	Political Science
Group VI	Geography, Philosophy, Journalism & Mass Communication
Group VII	English
Group VIII	Bengali, Hindi

For B.A. Degree in Economics:

- ECOA (for Honours Degree) or ECOG (for General Degree), and
- Any two subjects from the Arts & Humanities Group as follows: (Education or Film Studies), History, Sanskrit, Political Science, (Philosophy or Journalism), English, (Bengali or Hindi).

For B.Sc. Degree in Economics:

- ECOA (for Honours Degree) or ECOG (for General Degree), and
- Any two subjects, with at least one from the Science Group as follows: (Physics or Education or Film Studies), (History or Mathematics), (Chemistry or Sanskrit), Political Science, (Geography or Philosophy or Journalism), English, (Bengali or Hindi) with at least one from – Physics, Mathematics, Chemistry, Geography.
